



objective:

To collect the most pair of cards.

how to play:


Print the sheets attached and cut along the dotted lines creating individual cards for each image. Next, shuffle the cards and lay them on the table face down.

Flip a coin to see which player will go first. If you don't have a coin the youngest player shall go first. Then play clockwise.

Upon each turn, the player will flip over a card to find an image then flip over another card in an attempt to match the image of the first flipped card. If the two cards match the player gets to keep the pair. If the player successfully matches the pair they get to go again.

If the player turns over two cards and they do not match, turn the cards back to face down in the same spot and the next player shall go.


The goal is to remember where each image is so when its your turn you can match the cards and collect the pair.
